Solar for Retail Shop



Ronald King and Matches Surfwear, is a family owned community focused retail clothing shop, based in Lilydale and Croydon.

Energy Wired designs and installs solar solutions for businesses, not for profits, and homes across Victoria. Helping our customers save money and reduce their carbon footprint.

Opportunity

Ronald King and Matches Surfwear is an established retail clothing store. As a small business they wanted to reduce their overhead costs and save off their energy bill. With a North facing roof they had optimal position for solar power generation.

Challenge and Solution

We provided a proposal with designs for several options of solar products and solutions to meet their needs as a small business.

The retail store is in a public area with customers coming in and out of the shop on Main Street Croydon. During our installation we needed to ensure there was no disruption to customers, employees or risk to their safety.

We turned the power off for final electrical connection outside of the shop opening hours.

We installed a 19.17 kiloWatt solar system, including 54 REC Twin Peak panels, and SMA Inverter. As partners of REC and SMA we can offer Ronald King longer warranty than other installers.
